## **Lead-Out Initial Attack Line**

<u>Objective</u>: Develop skills necessary to place an initial attack line into operation in a smooth and effective manner.

<u>Overview</u>: It is well known that the success of many initial attack operations ranging from car fires to structure fires relates to how effectively the engine company is able to lead-out the attack line. This drill will emphasize these skills in order to improve your companies initial attack efficiency.

## **Drill Instructions**

- Instructor will determine the initial attack line (s) that will be used for this session.
- 2. Give members instructions on department procedure for pulling line and leading out.
- 3. Identify an objective such as a doorway or other area to simulate fire area.
- Identify protective equipment required for this operation and instruct members on proper use.
- At instructors order, deploy attack handline (s) to objective area using the number of members who would normally be assigned to that operation
- 6. Using stopwatch, time the length of each trial of this drill until a satisfactory time is reached by the crew.
- 7. Rebed hose as instructed.
- 8. Review crew performance.
- 9. Repeat as necessary.
