Don assigned PPE and position in apparatus in seated and belted position. Confirm partners do the same.	Ensure all crew members are in safe riding positions and know scene duties before arrival.	Operate vehicle safely and position to best functional and safety position upon arrival	Ensure all personnel in seated and belted position before vehicle moves. Monitor actions of driver.	Monitor dispatch for appropriate response level and scene location information.
Safely exit apparatus with assigned tools and equipment	Begin size-up of situation from exterior noting exits, water supply, bldg. construction type, occupancy.	Prepare apparatus for operation in event fire or problem is identified.	Perform size-up of critical scene factors and transmit initial radio report and follow-up reports as necessary	Establish command, make initial action plan assignments
Deploy to occupancy with partner and crew to determine problem origin.	Monitor instructions from officer for actions to be completed.	Monitor personnel entry point, location and assignment	Determine origin of alarm and assess occupants activity and location.	Upgrade or downgrade response as indicated by recon information from company.
Take actions necessary to mitigate or investigate the problem at direction of officer.	Establish an on-going awareness of building layout and access / egress points and other significant hazards.	Await further orders. Keep apparatus in ready state. Consider all possible outcomes.	Investigate cause for activation and provide follow-up reports to I/C on situation.	Render alarm status in/out of order, provide for notification of occupants.
If no problem found, take opportunity to learn building layout and characteristics.	Observe and discuss responsibilities of driver and company officer to learn jobs.	Ensure all tools and equipment are properly stored before departure.	Initiate proper actions as problem is identified.	Prepare final documentation of response and actions taken.
