# Possible MAYDAY Situations

1. You feel you are at risk for any reason
2. You get tangled, pinned or stuck
3. You fall through a roof
4. You fall through a floor
5. Conditions deteriorate and indicate that a flashover, backdraft or other fire behavior emergency is imminent
6. You get disoriented for any reason
7. Your primary exit is blocked for any reason and you cannot find a second exit
8. Your low air alarm is activated and you cannot find an exit door or window
9. You cannot find an exit door or window for any reason
10. You are injured or have a medical emergency
11. You have become separated from your crew
12. Your partner is in distress
13. A collapse has occurred that has blocked your egress or trapped you
14. Your partner is missing or lost
15. You have any type of PPE issue that puts you in distress

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# Sample MAYDAY Radio Drill

**OBJECTIVE:** Demonstrate the ability to call a MAYDAY message on portable radio

**MATERIALS NEEDED:** Firefighter in full protective clothing, full scba and portable radio equipment.

**STUDENT INSTRUCTIONS:** You will be asked to simulated firefighting operations in which you will encounter an emergency described to you by the instructor. After you are told what type of emergency you are facing, you will issue a MAYDAY report on your portable radio containing the **LUNAR** information. You will be given one opportunity to complete this skill by successfully completing all items on this skill sheet. If you are not successful you will not be re-tested until you have had additional instruction and practice.

**INSTRUCTOR INSTRUCTIONS:** Provide the student with instructions and describe scenario. The student will only be permitted one attempt to complete all the items listed below. If they are NOT successful they will be required to receive additional instruction and practice before attempting the skill again. Place a check in the appropriate column as they complete the steps listed below. Any comments for improvement should be placed in the comments section. If a student does not complete a step correctly, in the comments section list the step number and comments on improvement.

SAMPLE STEPS	PASS	FAIL
Don all PPE and attach regulator to facepiece and begin breathing		
Receive scenario description from instructor on emergency situation		
Grasp portable radio microphone and depress emergency button if equipped		
Initiate MAYDAY message in calm, clear tone speaking into microphone. State LUNAR report to I/C: o Your <b>L</b> ocation, <b>U</b> nit, <b>N</b> ame, <b>A</b> ssignment, <b>R</b> esources needed		
Await confirmation of your LUNAR report, begin to take correct standard emergency actions		
Activate PASS		
Provide updates on LUNAR as indicated by assigned scenario		
Notify I/C when self-rescue or RIT assistance is complete
